BOOKS:

Kindergarten students will receive many free books that were donated last year to our new kindergarten students. Each student will have time to pick at least three books to help them grow their home library.

BUSES:

Learning about the <u>School Bus</u> is very important. Staff members will speak to Kindergarten students about school bus safety, rules and required behavior while riding the bus to and from school.

BEARS:

Kindergarten students are also asked to bring a <u>stuffed Bear</u> as a 'Bus Buddy'! Students will have the opportunity to take their Bear along with them for a ride on a school bus for the first time! Taking a test ride helps the Kindergarten students become familiar and comfortable with the school bus before starting their first day!
