Is your son between the ages of 6 and 11 and having difficulty at home, school or in the community? Is he exhibiting any of the following behaviors?

- Defiance
- Lying
- Yelling/Screaming Swearing
- Bullying/Meanness Towards Others
- Intense Anger
- Fighting
- Stealing/Shoplifting

If so, he may qualify for a new **FREE** program in called the Auberle SNAP™ For Boys Program. SNAP stands for Stop Now And Plan and is an exciting award winning program designed to help young at-risk boys create a successful future. SNAP helps boys deal effectively with their anger by teaching them to stop and think before they act.

Your child may also qualify for a **PAID** research study conducted by the University of Pittsburgh on different treatment methods for boys who have behavioral problems. Participation in the study is voluntary, but if you decide to participate in the study you will be paid up to \$200 for your time, and your son will receive either one of two kinds of high quality behavioral programs. Either way, there will be **NO COST** to you for any of the services or participation in the research study.
