Students in 4th grade will be completing a "Book In A Bag Project" during the month of December. Students will be picking their favorite fictional chapter book to read. When students are finished reading, they will complete a book report on a paper bag! The students will be able to use their own unique creativity to complete their project. They will need to include the title, author, and draw a scene from the book on the front of the bag. On the back of the bag they will write a short summary of the book. Students will also create a Venn diagram comparing two of the characters in their book and on the other side of the bag they will list 10 new interesting words they learned with definitions. Students will critique their story by giving it a 1-5 STAR rating. Last, students can put up to 8 items in the bag that go along with their story. Students will use these objects when they give their "book report talk" to the class. Projects are due by December 17th and then the story telling begins!
