I attended the first New Federal Programs Coordinator training at the AIU for the 16 - 17 school year conducted by Erin Oberdorff from the Department of Education. Erin gave an overview of the various items and topics that would be discussed over the next several meetings. One of the topics to be discussed will be successful Title I parent involvement programs. The IU contacted Mrs. McCoy and me in regards to sharing some of our ideas of the successful programs we have had over the past couple of years.

Mrs. McCoy and I went over the Title I staff's Monthly Summary Reports. We also spent time looking over the Title I teachers' schedules for the 16 - 17 school year in their respective labs. We will meet with them on an individual basis if needed to discuss their schedules.

The Split Funding Report for September verifies that a percent of my time has been spent working on Federal Programs. The report will be submitted to Mr. Mac Fann to sign.

Mrs. McCoy showed me the process to complete the quarterly reports that are due in October, January, April and July. This report is found on the financial page of PDE. This site can show you when the reports are due, what funds have been sent for each Federal Program and when the next payment is expected.

I gathered the information on the staff and student information from the 15 - 16 school year from the end-of-the-year data received from the Title I staff. This information will need to be entered into the PIMS recordkeeping and uploaded to PDE.

We held our first Title I meeting on Monday, September 26th at 1:00 p.m. at Logan Elementary. We discussed the criteria the labs use to formulate their student population. The staff was told to have their populations to Mrs. McCoy by October 3rd. We also did some brainstorming on possible parent meetings/activities. A discussion was held on losing a Title I teacher and the impact it will have on instruction as well as the number of students that are being served.
