What is a Parent Advisory Council?

Parent Advisory Councils (PAC) - Each Title I school is required to have a Title I Parent Advisory Council (PAC). Two parents/guardians are selected to serve as chairman and co-chairman of the school's Title I PAC. Title I teachers work with the school's principal and or Federal Programs Coordinator and the Parent Advisory Council chairmen in approving a Title I Parent Policy for the school. All Title I schools are required to hold an annual Title I meeting at the beginning of the school year. This affords the parents the opportunity to learn more about Title I and begins a communication process between parents/teachers/school administrators. The Parent Advisory Council can be involved in other Title I program throughout the school year, helping to set goals and grant spending.

Roles-

- Attend the Advisory Council Meetings
- Help review and confirm the Parental Involvement Policy/Plan
- Act as an advocate for the Parent Involvement Program
