

# EAST ALLEGHENY SCHOOL DISTRICT UPON ARRIVAL SCREENING TOOL

 **START HERE**

Students will have temperature scanned upon entry into the school.  
Does the student have a temperature of 100.4F or more?

**YES**  


**Escort the student to the designated quarantine location.**  
**HS: ABC Room**  
**Logan: Auditorium**  
**Notify School Nurse for Assessment.**

**Report to Class**



**If Student becomes symptomatic in class. Escort to designated quarantine location.**

**HS: ABC Room**  
**Logan: Auditorium**  
**Notify School Nurse for Assessment**

Per the School Nurse Assessment.  
Does the Student need to be sent home?

**YES**  


**Return to school when:**  
It has been 10 days since first symptoms appeared, **AND** your child has been fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication, **AND** symptoms have improved.  
**Parent must speak to school nurse prior to student returning.**

**NO**  


**Return to school when:**  
If not tested, stay home for 10 days from symptom onset **AND** at least 24 hours after fever resolution **AND** respiratory symptoms have improved  
**OR**  
If clinically cleared by primary medical doctor, or other health care provider, stay home until fever free for 24 hours **AND** symptoms have improved  
**OR**  
If a COVID-19 test is negative, stay home until fever free for 24 hours **AND** respiratory symptoms have improved  
**Parent must speak to school nurse prior to student returning.**

**Do the Student need sent home?**

**YES**  


**Student exhibits 1 of the following**

- Fever at or above 100.4F
- New or worsening cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty Breathing
- New loss of taste/smell

**OR**

**2 or more of the following**

- sore throat
- runny nose/congestion
- chills
- muscle pain
- nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
- headache
- fatigue
