As we prepare for the return of 4 days a week, we would like to remind families of a few safety/health requirements and recommendations to keep our school in session.

Please follow the screening tool below in regards to when your student has any symptoms

**Group A**  
**1 or more symptoms**

Fever (measured (100.4) or subjective)  
Cough  
Shortness of breath  
Difficulty breathing  
New olfactory disorder  
New taste disorder

**Group B**  
**2 or more symptoms**

Chills  
Rigors  
Myalgia  
Headache  
Sore throat  
Nausea or vomiting  
Diarrhea  
Fatigue  
Congestion or runny nose

**Stay home if, you or the student:**

- Have one or more symptoms in Group A **OR**
- Have two or more symptoms in Group B **OR**
- Are taking fever reducing medication.

If your student has symptoms and/or gets tested or has been exposed, please let the school nurses know.

Please make sure your contact information and emergency contact information are up to date in the event that your student needs picked up due to being ill. We ask that all students being sent home ill are picked up within the hour of being called to minimize spread of illness.
