RE: SNP Requirements for Summer Meals Outreach & SUN Meals Locator

MESSAGE:

Federal Regulation 7 CFR 210.12 (d) (2) requires all School Food Authorities (SFAs) operating the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to announce the availability and locations of free meals for students over the summer months, served through the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and the Seamless Summer Option (SSO). These two programs, along with SUN Meals to Go (Rural Non-Congregate summer meals), and SUN Bucks (also known as Summer EBT), are collectively called Sun Meals.

The requirement to advertise SUN Meals is effective even if the SFA is not participating in the SFSP or SSO.

SFAs may fulfill the requirement through posting on the school's website, flyers, phone calls, text messages, or other methods that inform the community of summer feeding availability. An example publication template is available on page two of this memo.
