Parents, staff, and students of **East Allegheny Jr./Sr. High School** will work together as partners to ensure the best possible education for all students. This includes working together to plan, design, implement, and evaluate the educational programs at **East Allegheny Jr./Sr. High School**.

- Provide parents and staff an opportunity to evaluate the Title I Program and have input in its implementation

- Solicit opinions/interests of parents at Title I meetings

- Encouraging access to technological programs such as harcourtschool.com and various learning websites provided by the school staff
- Accessing the East Allegheny curriculum based on PA state standards, located on the PDE website

- Providing childcare
- Sending home written reminders
- Asking for parental input through the use of an evaluation tool
- Holding an annual Open House
- Holding parent conferences during both day and evening hours.
