Safety Guidelines for After-School Athletic & Extracurricular Activities

To help ensure the safety of our students, staff, families, and fans, please review and follow these important rules when attending events or using District facilities.

Prohibited Items & Behaviors

- No alcohol
- No smoking, vaping, or tobacco products
- No open containers, coolers, cans, or bottles
- No lasers or fireworks
- No noisemakers (horns, bells, whistles, etc.)
- No weapons (including concealed firearms, knives, or other dangerous items)
- No hazardous materials or items deemed unsafe by school personnel
- No drones
- No pets

Any prohibited item found on school property will be confiscated.

Facility Use Guidelines

- Treat all District facilities with respect.
- Photo ID may be required for entry.
- No one is permitted on the track during school activities.
- Only food purchased at concession stands is allowed.
- No bags of any size are permitted inside stadiums or gymnasiums.
- No motorized or wheeled vehicles (bikes, scooters, rollerblades, skateboards, etc.) on fields or tracks.
- Do not place tape or markings on turf, track, or gym floors.
- Do not move any equipment (e.g., nets, hurdles).
- Only athletic shoes may be worn on the turf and track.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Dispose of all trash properly in garbage cans.

Student & Guest Expectations

- Students in grades K–8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- No re-entry is allowed once fans exit.
- Entry after halftime is only allowed for athletes' parents/guardians with a district-issued game pass.
- All patrons must pass through metal detectors upon entering facilities.

New Entry Procedure for Indoor Sports:

All fans attending indoor sports at the Jr./Sr. High School must enter through Door 14, the first door on the stadium side of the building.
