- ★ Please notify the school of any same-day transportation changes by 2:00 pm.

This ensures we have enough time to communicate the updated information to your child's teacher(s) and the staff responsible for dismissal.



- ★ Parents and guardians of car riders are able to start lining up for dismissal no earlier than 2:45pm. Lining up prior to this time causes unnecessary traffic at the lower campus. Dismissal starts promptly at 3:10pm. All parents should remain in their vehicles during the pickup process.
- ★ Car rider pick-up is not permitted in the inner loop. Please stay to the right at the "Y" and continue around the turn around. You will park along the side walk and share your child's pick up number with the designated staff member.
- ★ Please be sure to let your child's grade level secretary know of any transportation and or daycare details for the 25-26 school year.
