Under the Every Student Succeeds Act, states are required to designate schools for support and improvement based on both schoolwide (Comprehensive Support and Improvement) and student group (Additional Targeted Support and Improvement) performance on a range of academic and student success measures.

East Allegheny School District is one of roughly 100 schools statewide designated for Targeted Support and Improvement. This designation is based on data suggesting the need for additional supports to improve schoolwide performance in the following areas: academic proficiency on state assessments, academic growth, and for those students who are designated as economically disadvantaged. This designation will mean additional resources for our school and provide an opportunity for our school to partner with stakeholders to identify our school community's most pressing needs, select strategies to support those needs, and work together to implement the selected strategies.

You can be involved in the improvement process at East Allegheny School District in the following ways:

- Our Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) has agreed to support academic promotion of education by advertising within their weekly newsletter and by encouraging parents who work in the technology/computer science fields and other related industries to offer their expertise to help enhance the East Allegheny School District. With support of the PTO, the District hopes to grow our partnerships with other industries and businesses that create a pipeline to enhance educational opportunities for the students of the East Allegheny School District.
