## **Google Classroom**

Google Classroom is a web-based learning environment that offers a digital safe space for students to see upcoming homework assignments, teacher announcements, student questions, and other important class information. Students can submit their work directly through Google Classroom, and teachers can provide feedback, assign grades, and return their work. All your child's work stays organized and conveniently stored on Google Drive. Assignments are even automatically added to the Google Calendar based on their due dates. Essentially, the Google Classroom is where all your child's schoolwork is created, exchanged, and stored. Google classroom is a great connection tool for both students and parents.

The following are the various ways to access Google Classroom:

- Using your district issued chromebook or tablet, simply click the classroom icon
- Go to Google.com, click on the waffle board (the grid of nine small grey boxes that you find in the top right corner of your browser) and then click the Classroom icon.
- Open up a web browser (Google Chrome, preferably) and type the following address in the address bar: classroom.google.com

Once you have accessed the Google Classroom application, if you have not signed in already, you will be prompted to enter your login credentials. Your child's username is the same as their email address and follows the following format without the commas: First initial of first name, last name, 2 digit graduation year @eawildcats.net. Your child's password is an 8 character password with the following format: ea-{their student ID}. For example, if your child's name is John Doe and is graduating in 2023, and his student ID is 12345, he would use the following credentials to login:

Username: jdoe23@eawildcats.net

Password: ea-123465 (\*please note: you must enter the - )

As teachers set up their Google Classrooms, they will invite students to join the class. When students log into Google Classroom, they will see all of the courses that they have been invited to and will click JOIN for those classes as shown in the image.

After joining the class, students will have access to announcements, resources and assignments that teachers have posted.
