Parents and Guardians,

I hope that everyone is safe and doing what they can to stay healthy; promoting physical activity and keeping your children as mentally active as possible. I appreciate all the positive emails and comments from parents through this challenging time. I also understand that this is very hard for some families and I understand all the concerns. Please remember that we are here for you as much as possible and the teachers will work with you and your children through any academic issues. If you have any concerns, i.e. work is too much, too hard, don't know what to do, or need more work, please contact your teacher.

Additional devices for student use are arriving daily at the district and will be distributed shortly. The district has decided to distribute one device per family of three children. Families with more than three children will receive additional devices. If you have a device already, you are not on the list to receive another one at this time. After the conclusion of the school year, we will inform families on how to return these devices to the district. Additionally, instructional packets for April have been distributed to those families that need them. We will soon be distributing packets for May. Some families have chosen packets over a device. If you have a device and received a packet, please speak with your child's teacher regarding what to complete.

April Packets: If you have a packet from April, you may drop off at the lunch locations, locations listed on our website: www.eawildcats.net or drop off at Logan starting on Friday May 1, 2020 between 8 a.m and 4 p.m. There will be a table outside the main door with envelopes available for the submission of packets. Please place all your child's completed work and/or books in an envelope and label with your child's name and teacher, and drop in the designated bin.

May Packets: Teachers will notify parents if there is a packet for them to pick up at Logan. The dates and times for the May packet pick-up are:

Friday, May 1 and Monday, May 4 from 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-3:00
