**Re:                      Message from the Superintendent-Advanced Placement and Google Classrooms**

I am providing this information today to provide updates regarding Advance Placement courses and Google Classroom.

Today, the Advanced Placement Courses Coordinator, along with faculty members responsible for instructing Advanced Placement course at the high school level are meeting to discuss future instructional possibilities for students scheduled to participate in Advanced Placement exams as well as those enrolled in college courses offered by the East Allegheny School District. Following these meetings, teachers will be in contact with students enrolled in the AP and college courses.

Secondly today, the EASD will begin issuing the protocols to parents and guardians in order for students to log onto and access Google Classroom. Please be advised that Google Classroom related instruction will not begin until we have formal approval that all teachers have been provided refresher trainings and that all community members (parents and guardians) are given detailed instructions on how access this form of online education. In preparation for online instruction the EASD is continuing ask that all parents and guardians complete the Technology Survey found on the district webpage and Facebook page. The district is currently making arrangements to contact parents and guardians by phone and assist them in completing this survey.
