

Dear East Allegheny Community:

We hope that all of you and your families are doing well in these uncommon times. We continue to have our students and our families in mind and are working hard here at East Allegheny to make education and other student services available until we are able to resume normal operations.

We want to assure you that we consider looking after the well-being of our students to be essential, particularly during these challenging times which may be causing additional stress to our students and families. Our school counseling staff and administration are working closely with agencies such as TCV Community Services and Wesley Family Services to provide the following:

- Telephone/virtual school counseling services including individual student and parent meetings, college & career preparation, addressing academic concerns, and referrals for additional services.
- Virtual Student Assistance Program meetings weekly to receive referrals from teachers, other staff, and families regarding students for whom they have concerns. The Student Assistance Program is composed of school district professional staff who are trained to gather information and refer students to available resources for help.
- Tele-therapy for students who have been receiving school based therapy through TCV Community Services or drug and alcohol counseling through Wesley Family Services. Screenings to determine possible service needs are also available.
