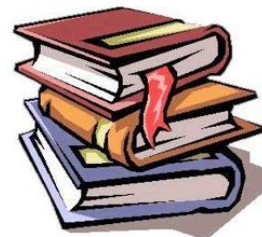


**LOGAN MIDDLE SCHOOL**  
**BATTLE OF THE BOOKS**  
**GRADES 4-5-6**



What is the Battle of the Books?

Students who wish to participate are to form teams of 6 and these teams have approximately one month to read 6 books. Ideally, each child should read 1 book. Mrs. Carlson has the books available for the team members to read and all teams will read the same books. Teams will select a teacher to act as their sponsor or Mrs. Carlson will pair the team up with a participating teacher or H.S. student. This sponsor will meet with team members periodically to monitor their progress as they read the books. This sponsor may act as a team captain during the even or the team may select a team member to act as captain. The Battle is limited to 20 teams of 6 students. The first 20 teams to register with Mrs. Carlson and sign out the books will participate. Other teams will be put on a waiting list in the event teams drop out.

On the day of the Battle, all students in grades 4-5-6 will report to the gym. The participating students will be on the gym floor with their student captain. Students are encouraged to show their team pride and dress up in any way they want, be creative (Team EA, Team Cats, Team Blue, Team Crazy Hair, and so on). A question will be asked to the students and they will have 30 seconds to a minute to answer the question. They will give their captain the answer, the answer will be announced and the team captain will hold up a 0 or a 3 depending if they got the answer right. Each story will have 2 questions as well as a question pertaining to the book's author. At the conclusion of the questions, the team scores will be added up and the winners will be announced and trophies given to the winners as well as the most creative teams. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Please encourage your child to participate in this fun event and have them create their team as soon as possible. Parents of participating students are welcome to attend.
